

North Park Neighbourhood Association Constitution

Updated as Approved October 4, 2017

Article 1: Name

The name of the organization shall be the North Park Neighbourhood Association

Article 2: Objectives

The objectives of North Park Neighbourhood Association are to:

- promote a community that works together to improve the neighbourhood and the quality of life in North Park;
- listen to and acknowledge the concerns of all North Park residents and businesses;
- advocate for North Park by providing advice, guidance and expertise to community partners;
- promote community awareness and involvement through outreach and communications activities;
- foster community participation with respect to development within the North Park area through statutory public meetings and ad hoc, issue-specific forums;
- actively liaise with other neighbourhoods in the Capital Regional District to promote the neighbourhood and develop best practices with respect to community organizing and development;
- enter into contracts and agreements with all levels of government and other organizations to improve the wellbeing of the community; and
- ensure that the community residents have a voice, through democratic processes, on all public projects within the neighbourhood.

Article 3: Operations

The North Park Neighbourhood Association operates in the North Park area as defined by the City of Victoria. This is roughly between the streets of Cook, Pandora, Blanshard, and Bay located in the City of Victoria, British Columbia.

Article 4: Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, the members of the North Park Neighbourhood Association shall appoint a special committee to liquidate the assets and liabilities of the Association, provided the assets of the Association be distributed to one or more recognized charitable organizations in Canada. Article 4 shall be unalterable.
