General Voting Day for the Crystal Pool Referendum will take place on **Saturday, February 8**, **2025**, from **8 a.m. to 8 p.m.** 



Three advance voting opportunities will be held at the **Crystal Garden**, **713 Douglas Street**, from **8 a.m. to 8 p.m.** on:

- Wednesday, January 29th, 2025
- Monday, February 3rd, 2025
- Wednesday, February 5th, 2025

Victoria voters will be asked whether the **City of Victoria** should borrow up to \$168.9 million to replace the Crystal Pool and select a preferred site option: **Central Park North** or **Central Park South**.

Applications open on February 1st, 2025. Three types of grants are available:

- Activity Grants: up to \$1,500
- Placemaking Grants: up to \$7,500
  Community Resilience Grants: up to \$7,500

#### 1520 Blanshard Street (Downtown) CALUC Meeting

- Project Overview: Reliance Properties is proposing a 35-storey mixed-use building at 1520 Blanshard Street, located just outside the North Park neighbourhood. The proposal features ground-floor retail, co-working space on the second floor, and residential units on the upper floors. The residential units include a mix of studio, one-bedroom, two-bedroom, and three-bedroom options. The plan also outlines a large public plaza as part of the development.
- CALUC Meeting Information: The CALUC meeting for this development is scheduled for Monday, February 10th, from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM at the Hotel Rialto (653 Pandora Avenue). Join us to learn more about the proposal and share your feedback with the applicant before the plans are submitted to the City of Victoria for review.

Three advance voting opportunities will be held at the Crystal Garden, 713 Douglas Street from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on:

- Wednesday, January 29th, 2025
- Monday, February 3rd, 2025
- Wednesday, February 5th, 2025

The voting process will comprise two questions:

- 1. Do you support the proposed pool facility and the City borrowing up to \$168.9M for its capital costs?
- 2. What is your preferred location for the facility: Central Park North or Central Park South?

Even if you vote "No" to the first question, your response to the second on location will still be counted.

Mark Wilson from the SOLID Outreach Society will provide an update on the Access Hub project at 2155 Dower Place.

# **Meeting Notes**

- People can be brought into a shelter overnight, but it is still a soft opening.
- The space is intended for detox and treatment.
- The outdoor area was too large and will need to be modified.
- There is a partial occupancy permit for the main floor.
- The main floor is complete, but the outdoor structure's status is unknown.
- The upstairs will be ready within a month.
- Approximately 25 people have been housed in the last month and a half.
- Once open, there are 25 mats on the floor, with plans to add bunk beds and lockers for individuals staying for one to two months.
- This is not a drop-in space. It is for individuals ready to get treatment.
- It's for people working with a case manager and is no longer a drop-in service.
- Services provided include ID assistance, health services, detox, and transportation.
- The daytime outreach team covers three blocks in all directions, while the night team is more concentrated on the building.
